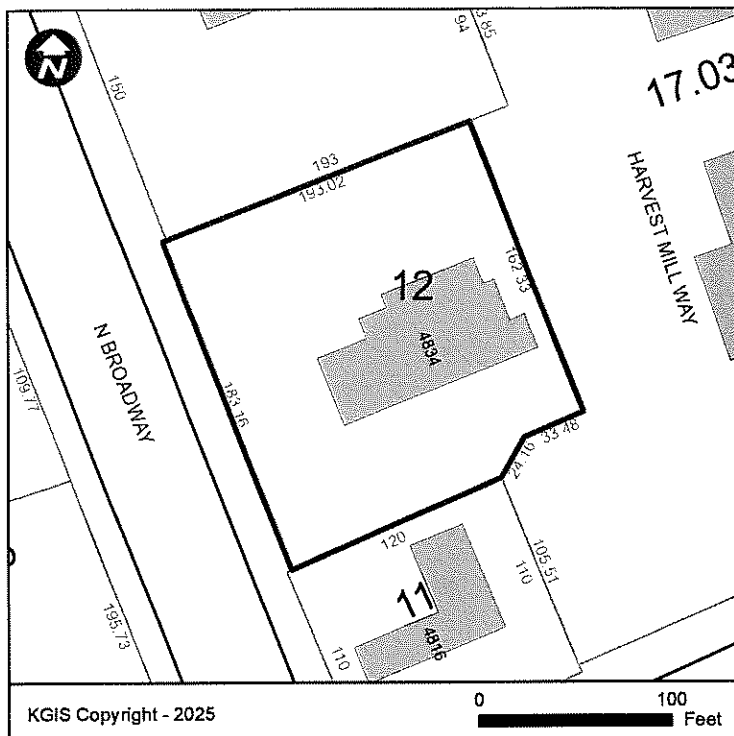

1. I/we WENDY LIZU hereby solemnly swear or affirm that each statement in this application is true and correct and understand that if any statement contained herein is false, the permit issued is automatically forfeited and voided. Furthermore, that in the event of forfeiture I/we shall not be eligible to receive another permit for a period of ten (10) years pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 57-5-105(d).
2. I/we understand that all applicants are charged with the responsibility of knowing the local and state beer laws. I/we are aware that the penalty for violating state or local beer laws can include revocation or suspension of the permit and/or the imposition of civil penalties up to ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,500.00) PER OFFENSE.
3. I/we understand that if the business allows illegal gambling on the premises that the beer permit will be subject to revocation.
4. I/we understand that a requirement of beer permit issuance is the permittee(s) and ON-SITE manager(s) who will supervise and/or sell and serve the beer at the establishment must complete alcohol education and training programs in accordance with City of Knoxville Code Section 4-60(c).
5. I/we understand that by submitting this application, a background investigation shall be conducted on the applicant(s) and on all ON-SITE managers who will be selling beer at the permitted establishment. It is further understood that any and all documents related to that investigation shall become public record open for public inspection and reproduction pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 10-7-503.
6. I/we understand that a requirement of maintaining good status standing with the Knoxville Beer Board, is that I/we must notify the City of Knoxville Business Tax Office each time there is a change in the on-site manager responsible for selling the beer.
7. I/we hereby release, absolve and hold harmless, the City of Knoxville, the Knoxville Beer Board, the Knoxville Police Department, its employees, agents and representatives from any and all liability of whatever type for any damages, causes of actions, personal property injuries which may result as a consequence of my application for a beer permit, background investigation, release of documents or any other matters related to my application. I/we hereby waive all possible liability of the City of Knoxville, Knoxville Beer Board, Knoxville Police Department, its employees, agents and representative as stated above.
8. I/we agree that the hiring of an employee who has been convicted within the past ten (10) years of any law relating to the sale, possession, manufacture or transportation of intoxicating beverages, including beer, as defined by City of Knoxville Code Section 4-37 or the hiring of an employee who has been convicted of any felony or crime involving moral turpitude within the past ten (10) years will be cause for possible revocation of the beer permit.
9. I/we understand if any information given in the application subsequently changes, I/we will immediately notify the Knoxville Beer Board c/o Business Tax Office.
10. I/we understand that if the business closes down, relocates, or there is ANY change in the ownership of the business, the permit will be surrendered to the Business Tax office within 15 days of said change for appropriate action.
11. I/we assume full responsibility for the permit and will be accountable for full compliance with the laws of Knoxville and the State of Tennessee in the sale of beer.
12. I/we have read the foregoing release. I/we fully understand its provisions, and voluntarily consent to abide by its requirements.
13. I/we acknowledge and understand that the fees paid for the beer permit application process are non-refundable.

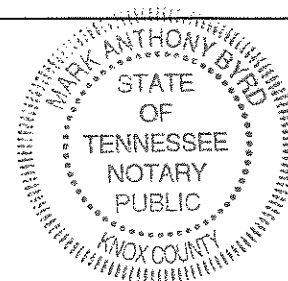

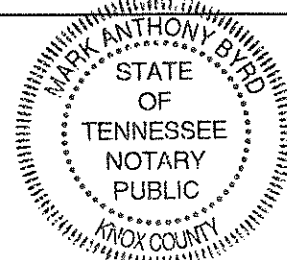

Alcohol Sales and Customer Oversight plan

For: Captain Crab

1. Purpose

The purpose of this plan is to ensure responsible alcohol service at Captain Crab, prevent overconsumption, and maintain a safe and enjoyable dining environment.

This plan aligns with all applicable state and local liquor laws while prioritizing customer well-being and staff accountability.

2. Staff Training and Certification

- All servers, bartenders, and managers must complete a state-approved alcohol training program before serving alcohol.

Training will include:

- Legal responsibilities regarding alcohol sales.
- Identifying valid IDs and preventing sales to minors
- Recognizing signs of intoxication
- techniques for refusing service professionally and safely.
- understand liability laws, including Dram Shop laws
- refreshing training sessions will held annually or as required by law

3. Preventing underage sales

- customers appearing under 35 years old must present a valid government-issued ID.
- Acceptable forms of ID include:
 - Drivers license
 - passport
 - state-issued identification card
 - military ID

Staff must check for:

- Expiration dates
- signs of tampering or forgery
- matching facial features with presented ID

If there is any doubt about an ID's validity, staff must request a second form of identification or deny service.

4. Preventing Overconsumption and overserving

- staff must observe guest behavior for intoxication signs include:

- slurred speech
- loss of coordination
- aggressive or disruptive behavior
- Drowsiness or confusion

If a customer shows signs of intoxication:

- step 1: politely slow down service and offer food or non-alcoholic beverages

step 2: Alert a manager to assess the situation

Step 3: If necessary, refuse further alcohol service and arrange safe transportation

4.2 Drink Limits and service Guidelines

- The restaurant will implement the following responsible serving guidelines:

- no more than one drink per guest per order unless part of a pre-approved special event
- no double shots, excessive alcohol pours, or oversized drinks
- no service to intoxicated patrons under any circumstances
- management may impose two-drink limit per hour (2) for guests showing signs of intoxication

5. Handling Difficult situations

If a guest is intoxicated or attempting to consume alcohol irresponsibly, staff must:

1. Remain calm and professional when refusing service

2. Use clear, polite language such as:

- "I'm sorry, but I can't serve you another drink at this time".

- "For your safety, we need to slow down your alcohol service."

3. call a manager to support the decision if the guest argues

4. Offer water, food, or assistance with transportation as needed.

5.2 Dealing with disruptive customers

- If a guest becomes aggressive or refuses to leave:

- the manager will intervene immediately

- staff may contact security or law enforcement if the situation escalates

- The guest may be banned from future service.

6. Policies for alcohol promotions and happy hours

- all promotions will comply with local laws

- Drink specials will be limited to reasonable discounts and will always include food pairings

- Happy hour promotions will have clear guidelines to prevent excessive consumption

7. Safe transportation and closing Procedures

If a guest is too intoxicated to drive, staff will:

- Offer to call a taxi or ride-share
- Encourage them to wait inside the restaurant until a ride arrives
- If necessary, involve law enforcement if an intoxicated person attempts to drive

7.2 End-of-night alcohol procedures


- alcohol sales will stop 45 minutes before close or earlier as per management discretion
- staff will monitor guests at closing to ensure responsible departures

8. Compliance and Record-Keeping

- management will conduct regular compliance checks and staff audits
- any incidents related to alcohol service will be documented and reported to management
- Compliance with this plan is mandatory for all employees, and violations may result in disciplinary action, including termination

9. conclusion

Captain Crab is committed to responsible alcohol service and customer safety. This plan will be strictly enforced to create a positive and safe dining experience for all guests.
