WHEREAS, in an effort to provide a wide variety of quality recreational experience to the citizens and residents of the City of Knoxville, the City owns and participates in the operation of three (3) golf courses within the corporate limits of the City of Knoxville, including the Knoxville Municipal Golf Course, Whittle Springs Golf Course and Williams Creek Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, in order to enhance the quality of the recreational experience which is afforded to the citizens by these various golf facilities, City Council by Resolution R-156-2012 created the Knoxville City Golf Course Advisory Committee as a permanent committee, the purpose of the Committee was to offer advice to appropriate authorities concerning issues relative to equipping, maintaining and operation the various municipal golf facilities; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution R-156-2012, the membership criteria of the Committee and the length of term of the membership were established; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Resolution, Councilmember Parker seeks to appoint Kimberly Mays as the At Large Seat C representative of this Committee, for a term expiring December 17, 2027; and

WHEREAS, City Council is of the opinion that Kimberly Mays is well qualified to serve on the Committee and City Council desires to make such appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KNOXVILLE:

SECTION 1: The Council of the City of Knoxville hereby appoints Kimberly Mays to serve as the At Large Seat C representative on the Knoxville City Golf Course Advisory Committee for a term expiring December 17, 2027.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
