WHEREAS, The City of Knoxville filed Application No. 1-A-25-SNC with the Knoxville-Knox County Planning Commission (“Planning Commission”) to change the street name of Willow Avenue to Patton Street between Florida Street and McCalla Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Staff recommended approval of the street name change to Patton Street; and

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2025, the Planning Commission approved the street name change to Patton Street; and

WHEREAS, public notice for the hearing of this petition was published in the *Knoxville News Sentinel* on December 6, 2024, and public notice for the City Council Meeting on February 4, 2025 was published in the *Knoxville News Sentinel* on January 15, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KNOXVILLE THAT:

SECTION 1: The street name of Willow Avenue between Florida Street and McCalla Avenue shall be changed to Patton Street.

SECTION 2: The following Planning Commission documents are attached as Collective Exhibit 1 to this Ordinance and made a part hereof by reference: The Knoxville-Knox County Planning Commission Street/Road Name Change report including all appendices; a portion of the Zoning Map on which the above described street is shaded; an excerpt from the Minutes of the Planning Commission meeting of January 9, 2025; the Street Name Change Request; and Public Notice.

SECTION 3: If any part, sentence, phrase, clause, term, word, section, subsection, or provision of this ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect seventeen (17) days from and after its passage, the welfare of the City requiring it.
