A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KNOXVILLE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH WILDLANDS ENGINEERING, INC. TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE MARY VESTAL PARK STREAMBANK STABILIZATION PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$88,000.00, FUNDED WITH THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent for the City of Knoxville (the “City”) issued a notice to consultant engineers regarding a request for qualifications and letters of interest to provide construction engineering and inspection (CEI) services for the Mary Vestal Park Streambank Stabilization Project (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Project consists of the stabilization of 900 linear feet of streambank for Goose Creek in Mary Vestal Park; and

WHEREAS, an evaluation committee reviewed the submissions and determined that Wildlands Engineering, Inc. was the most qualified firm, and after review of its detailed

scope of services and proposed fee, recommends the Project be awarded to Wildlands Engineering, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Wildlands Engineering, Inc. to provide professional CEI services for the Project in an amount not to exceed Eighty-Eight Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$88,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Project is funded with the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) grant through the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KNOXVILLE:

SECTION 1: The Mayor of the City of Knoxville is hereby authorized to execute an agreement, in substantially the same form as the agreement attached hereto, with Wildlands Engineering, Inc. to provide professional CEI services for the Mary Vestal Park Streambank Stabilization Project, in an amount not to exceed Eighty-Eight Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$88,000.00), funded with the ARPA grant.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the City requiring it.
