A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KNOXVILLE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ROGERS GROUP, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,365,594.00 FOR THE 2025 RESURFACING PHASE I PROJECT.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Knoxville (the “City”) advertised for bids for the 2025 Resurfacing Phase I Project (the “Project”) and will bid Phase II in Spring of 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project will include approximately 20 equivalent miles of resurfacing streets in Council Districts 3, 4 and 5 including approximately 0.24 equivalent miles for the Knoxville Utilities Board (KUB) for resurfacing streets that were damaged through utility cuts; and

**WHEREAS**, Rogers Group, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive bid for the Project in the amount of Five Million Three Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,365,594.00); and

**WHEREAS,** Rogers Group, Inc. has the necessary qualifications and expertise to perform said work and the Department of Engineering recommends the contract be awarded to it; and

**WHEREAS,** KUB will fund approximately One Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-One and 00/100 Dollars (\$184,651.00) for the approximately 0.24 equivalent miles included.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KNOXVILLE:**

**SECTION 1:** The Mayor of the City of Knoxville is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Rogers Group, Inc., in substantially the same form as the one attached hereto, in an amount not to exceed Five Million Three Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,365,594.00) for the 2025 Resurfacing Phase I Project, as set forth in the bid and contract documents.

**SECTION 2:** This Resolution shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the City requiring it.
